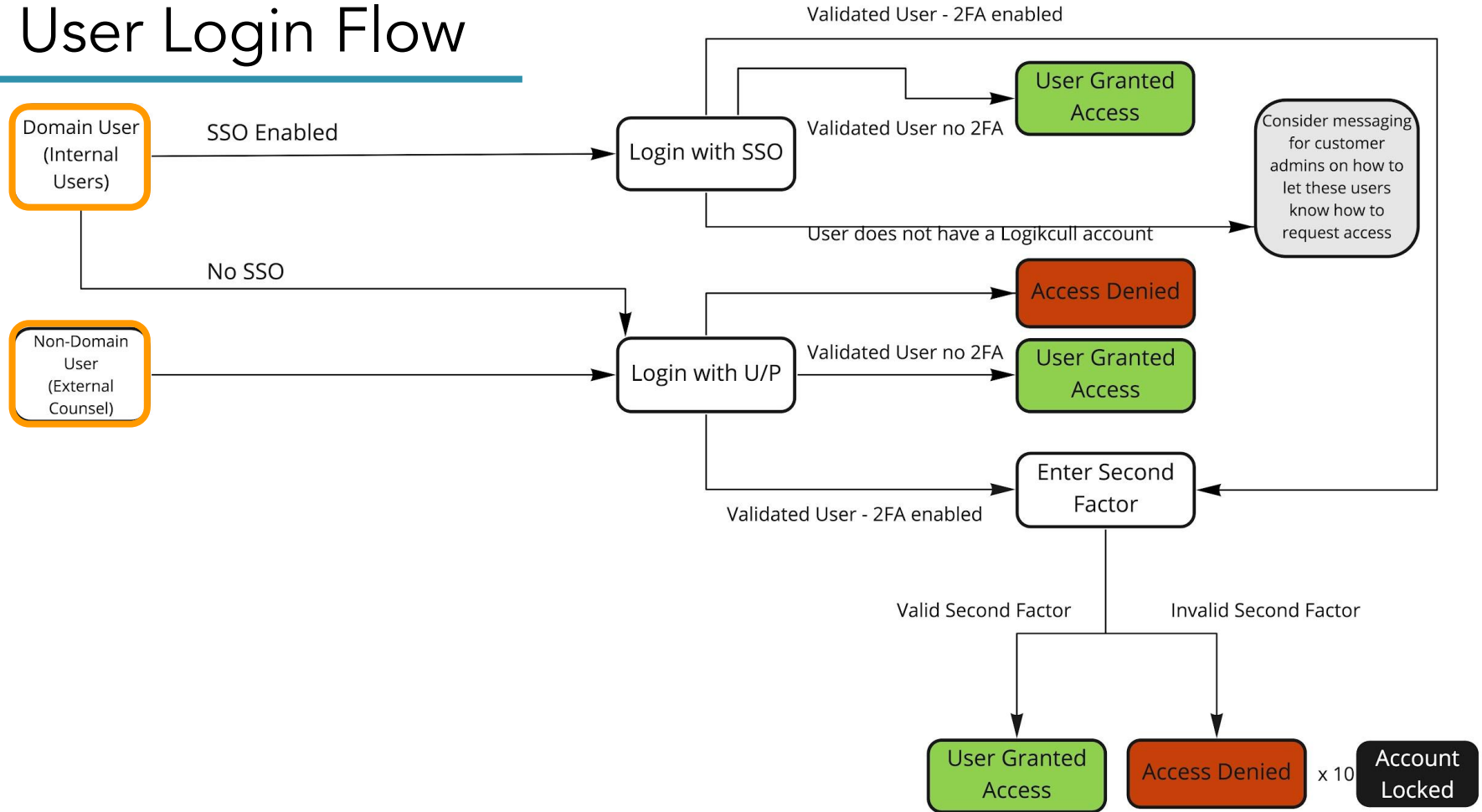

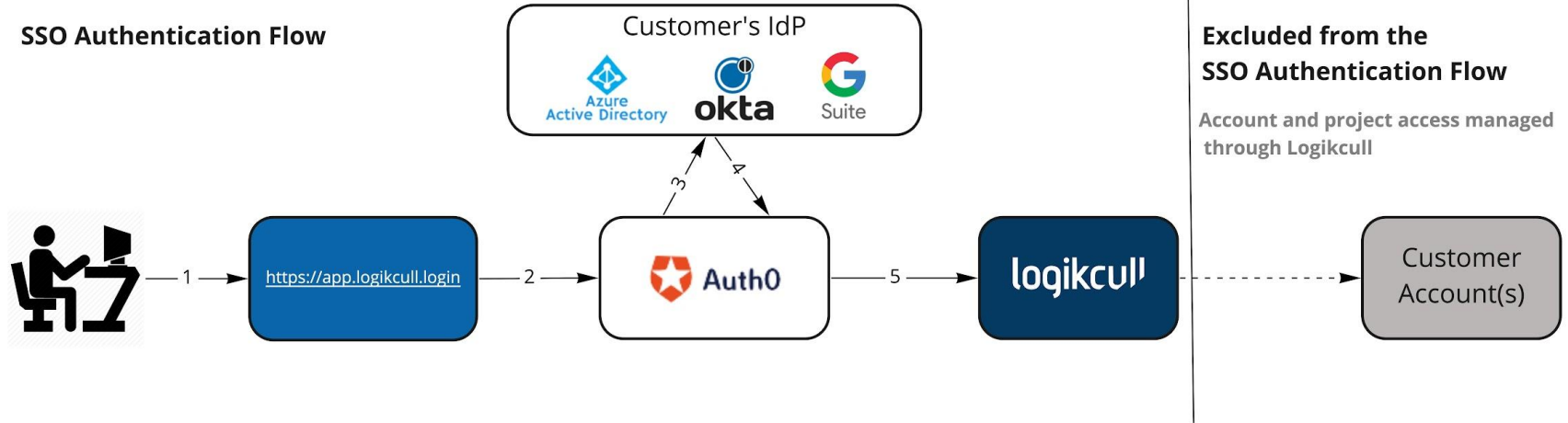

User Login Flow

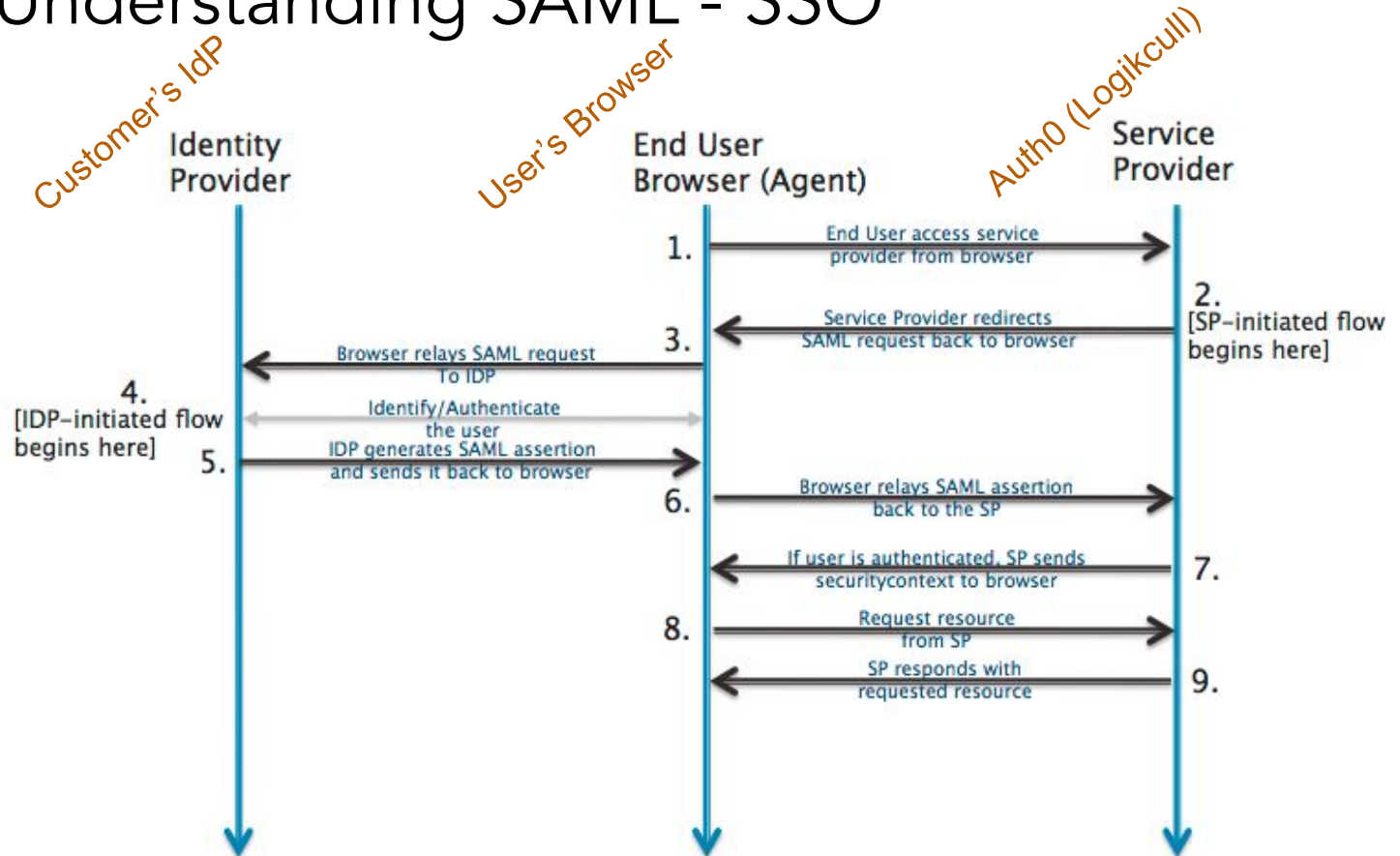


Logikcull, Auth0 and the customer's IdP

Changes related to SSO

- An SSO user cannot update their email or password
- An SSO user is not required to enter a password to reset their 2FA

Key things to know

- SSO is a premium feature- only customers on a premium plan may
- An SSO user is not required to enter a password to reset their 2FA
- New users must be added to the Customer's account in Logikcull AND assigned to the Logikcull app in the customer's IdP
